QUICK LESSON 4 24th JULY 2020

Over the first three lessons we have been steadily building the structure of the song Let It Be. Firstly, concentrating on the strum, then the verse chords and the options for playing the riffs within the song. These riffs can be easy or more challenging depending upon your level of experience. Whether you play the easy riff or the more challenging ones they are all valid and will add to the sound of the song when played together.

Last time we looked at the chords for the chorus which again utilises the Riff over the final C and G chords.

In Quick lesson 4 we are going to learn the Intro strum and then go in to singing the 1^{st} verse and chorus.

Once we have this we have the basis for the whole song.

There is an interlude in the song and next week we will cover how to play this.
